

Instructions for Contributors

Journal of Agriculture and Technology (JAT) is a biannual double blind peer reviewed print and on line journal published by the Cooch Behar Association for Cultivation of Agricultural Sciences in English.

Aims and scope: This journal publishes the new results of completed, original studies on any aspect of agriculture and other related fields. We also accept descriptions of original methods and instruments opening novel possibilities for obtaining and analyzing experimental results. Papers outlining trends and hypotheses are accepted as well. Review articles, chronicles of congresses and conferences, and book reviews are published at the invitation of the Editorial Board as a rule.

Manuscript submission implies that the material has not been published before and is not under consideration for publication anywhere else.

Manuscript requirements: Manuscript length should not exceed 06 printed pages, including references, tables, and figures. The manuscript must be typed (Arial font, 12 pt, double-spacing throughout) in a single column on one side of white paper (A4, 210 × 297 mm) with left and top margins of 2.5 cm and a right margin of 1.5 cm and printed using a high-quality printer. All pages should be numbered consecutively. The soft copy along with at least two names of probable reviewer may be sent to Editor, Journal of Agriculture and Technology, Department of Genetics and Plant Breeding, Uttar Banga Krishi Viswavidyalaya, Pundibari, Cooch Behar 736 165, West Bengal, INDIA or may be sent as e-mail attachment to editorjat2014@gmail.com

Please arrange your manuscript as follows:

Title: Title must be concise but informative. Capitalize the first letters in all nouns, pronouns, adjectives, verbs, adverbs, and subordinate conjunctions. Provide names of all authors and their postal addresses and telephone and fax numbers, as well as e-mail addresses, and indicate the corresponding author by “*”. Author affiliations include the department, institution, and complete address of each author.

Abstract: All papers should be preceded by a concise (within 250 words) but informative abstract, in which the plant material (binomial, including authority) is given. The abstract is typed as a single paragraph. Citing and discussing literature are not recommended.

Key words: Not more than 05

Text: Research papers include three parts- **INTRODUCTION, MATERIALS AND METHODS, RESULTS AND DISCUSSION**. Sub-titles may be included as per the requirement of the article. Describe procedures in sufficient detail so that the work can be repeated. Review articles and short communications may be organized according to their specific requirements.

References: The author-date system is used for citing references (Sarkar, 2013; Das and Roy, 2011; Pradhan *et al.*, 2010). Only published or in-press literatures may be cited in the reference list. Abstracts of papers presented at meetings are not permitted. List all personal authors in the references. References should be given in alphabetical order according to the following examples:

Articles or chapters in books

Tables: Each table should have a brief title. Each column should have a heading; units should appear under the column heading(s). Some remarks may be written below the table, but they should not repeat details given in the Materials and Methods section.

Figure Captions must be a brief self-sufficient explanation of the illustrations. All figures (photographs, graphs, and diagrams) should be cited in the text and numbered consecutively throughout.

The **electronic version** is formed as a complete manuscript file, without figures. Text files should be submitted in Microsoft Word 6.0 or a later version, using Times New Roman font of 12 point size. Submit figures as separate files. The preferred figure format is TIFF or JPEG.

Editorial processing

The Editorial Office will inform authors by e-mail that a manuscript is received.

All manuscripts submitted will be reviewed double blind. The reviewer evaluates the manuscript, suggests improvements, and recommends accepting or declining the paper. Manuscripts and reviewer's comments are emailed to the authors. Revised manuscripts (two copies and the initial version, along with point-by-point responses to the referee) should be returned within 15 days; otherwise, they will be treated as new submissions. Manuscripts sent to the Editorial Office are not returned to the authors.

Processing fees

Processing fee per article is Rs. 500.00 for all. Any non-members submitting a manuscript will be required to become at least annual member for publishing their article. All authors are required to become member.

After publication, the authors may receive PDF copy.
